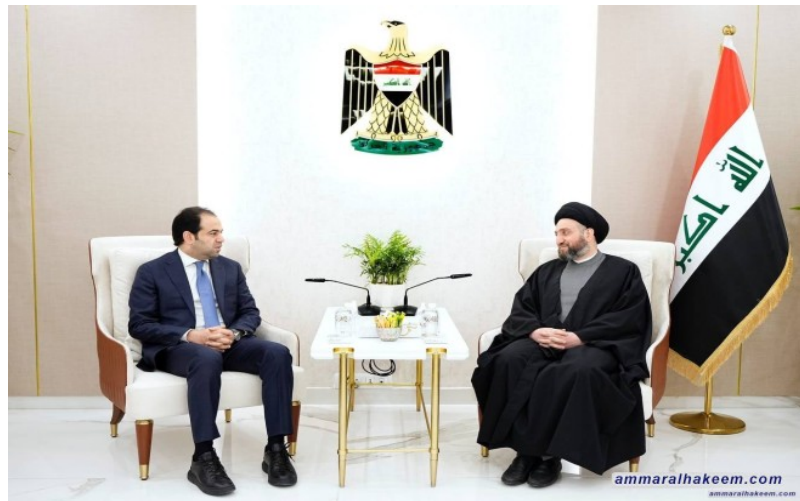


Sayyid Al-Hakeem to Muslim Scholars: Terrorism lost its Iraqi social incubators, grand achievement



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, received the delegation of Muslim Scholars headed by the Secretary-General, Counselor Mohammed Abdulsalam on 17/1/2023. His Eminence expressed gratitude for visiting Iraq and having a real insight into its security and social, political, and cultural improvements.

H.E. illustrated the nature of political changes in Iraqi reality, and the importance of Iraq's stability as a need for the safety and stability of the region.
