

Sayyid Al-Hakeem calls for optimism and positivity in Iraqi society



At the host of the Albu Zaid clans east of Baghdad and at the host of Sheikh Khudhair Al-Zaidawi on 22/3/2023, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement blessed those present with the advent of the holy month of Ramadan, recalling the common history they shared at pivotal stations in Iraq's history. H.E. stressed that Iraq was saved by the trilogy of Religious Authority, Husseinite rites, and Iraqi clans, indicating that the generosity shown on more than one occasion is a Husseinite culture.
