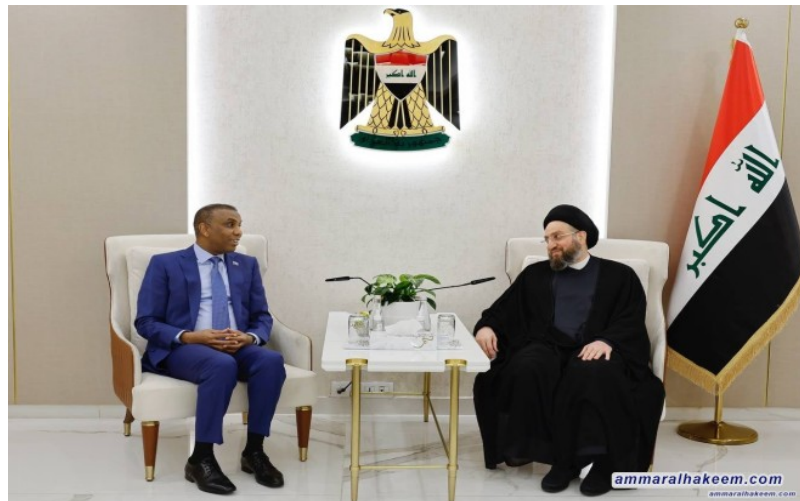


Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Somalian Prime Minister's visit to strengthen both countries ties
