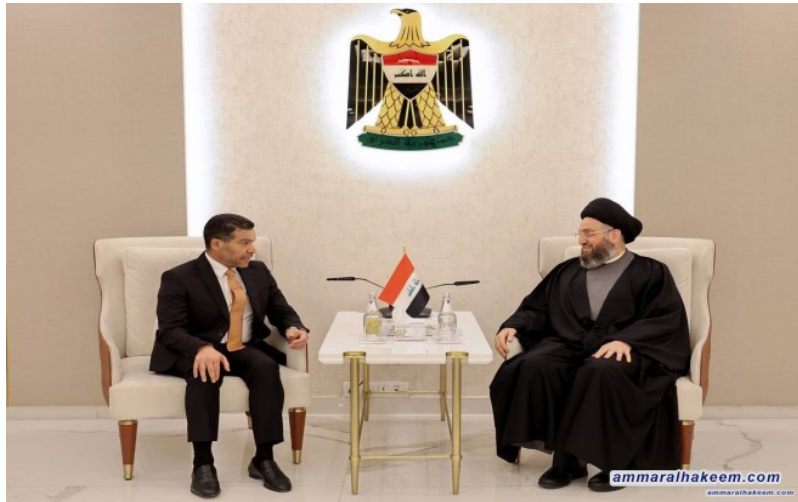


Sayyid Al-Hakeem Emphasizes Empowering Syrians to Make Political Decisions and Manage Their Country



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with the Head of the Arab Project, Sheikh Jamal Al-Dari, to discuss the latest political developments in Iraq and the region, particularly the situation in Syria.
