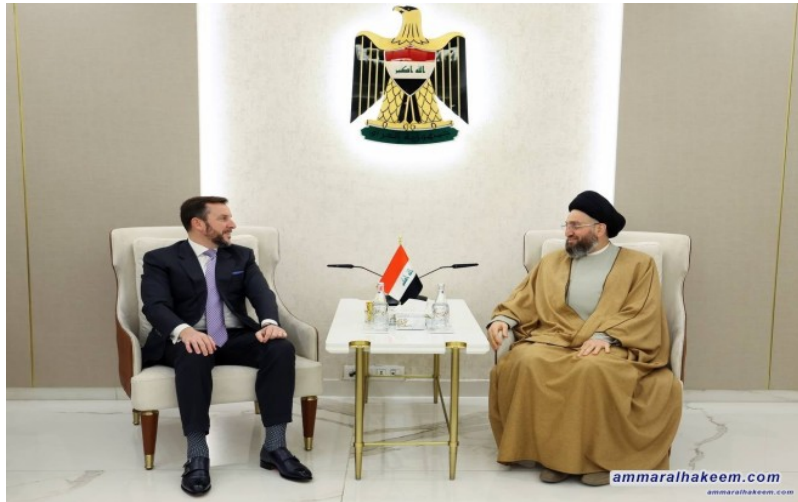


Sayyid Al-Hakeem to the Italian Ambassador: Iraq's Stability is Essential for Regional and Global Stability
