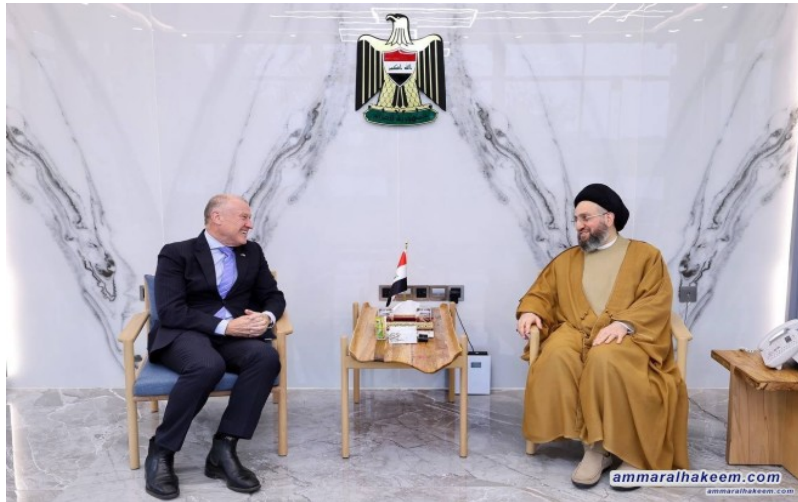


Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Iraq Is Experiencing Unprecedented Stability and Public Satisfaction Driven by Reconstruction and Development
